

Do donations in-kind qualify for 80G deduction?

Donations in kind do not qualify for 80G deduction. So lets us say a donor gives you four computers and says it's a lakh of rupees. He cannot get a fifty percent deduction on that. Although the value maybe one lakh or even more.

He can give you one lakh rupees and say go ahead and buy computers. Or unless he gives a brand new vehicle for your rural development welfare programme. Say the vehicle is costing rupees ten lakh rupees, he can't claim 80G.

But he can give you ten lakh rupees and ask you to go and buy a vehicle and you can do all this mobile clinic in the villages. So In Kind donation to don't qualify for 80G deduction
